Many disparaging social attitudes and behaviours relating to both physical disability and to women stunt the psychological and spiritual development of women with a physical disability. Elizabeth Martiny, (Ph.D) worked several years as a special education teacher and as a therapist in the United States. She received a diploma in analytical psychology at the C.G. Jung Institute, Zürich, Switzerland after which she has been practicing as a Jungian analyst in Gauteng since 1995. She has given numerous seminars to Jungian groups in Gauteng, Bloemfontein, Pretoria and Cape Town. She has presented papers at Jungian conferences: the International Association for Analytical Psychology (IAAP) and the Association of Graduates of Analytical Psychology of the C.G. Jung Institute, Zürich (AGAP). For her doctoral research at UKZN, she used an interdisciplinary approach of theology and analytical psychology to study God-images of women with a physical disability.
